ORDINANCE 2011-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE TWO: ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS, CHAPTER THREE: LICENSE CLASSES AND FEES, SECTION 1A: CLASS A

WHEREAS, the Village of Pecatonica ("Village") is a duly-organized Illinois Municipal Corporation, operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-1, et.seq.);

WHEREAS, the Village of Pecatonica is authorized to establish and enforce rules and regulations pertaining to alcoholic liquors within the Village limits and has done so through Article Two of the Village Code, which is entitled, "Alcoholic Liquors;"

WHEREAS, Chapter Three of Article Two does not clearly establish rules and regulations pertaining to a person under 21 years of age being present in Class A establishments within the Village;

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the Village of Pecatonica that the Village Code be amended to include language pertaining to persons under 21 years of age being present in Class A establishments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. Article Two: Alcoholic Liquors, Chapter Three: License Classes and Fees, Section 1A: Class A, of the Municipal Code of Pecatonica, is hereby amended with the addition of Paragraph 6 as follows:

6. It shall be a violation of this section for any person under 18 years of age to enter upon any Class A licensed premises after 8:00 PM unless such person is accompanied by his parent or legally appointed guardian, or such person is in the exercise of his legitimate business, trade, or employment.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.
