ORDINANCE NO. 2013-01

AN ORDINANCE BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN SURPLUS MUNICIPAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>65 ILCS 5/11-76-4</u> and other statutory provisions, the Village of Pecatonica, Winnebago County, Illinois ("Village") is authorized and empowered to adopt and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, <u>65 ILCS 5/11-76-4</u> authorizes the Village to sell personal property in any manner approved by Ordinance when that property is no longer useful or necessary to the Village and the sale would be in the best interest of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village now desires to sell certain personal property as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of a majority of the corporate authorities now holding office that such personal property is no longer useful or necessary to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities have determined that the sale of such personal property is in the best interests of the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals are incorporated by reference herein and made a part hereof.
- 2. <u>Authorization</u>. The Village Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Village Clerk to sell or dispose of the following personal property:

The brass unused and outdated Hersey water meters currently stored at the Pecatonica Public Works building at 200 Taylor Street.

The Village Clerk is authorized to advertise and sell the aforementioned property without further action by the Board in any manner not inconsistent with the Village Code of Ordinance or state law. All sale proceeds shall be deposited in the Village's Water/Sewer Fund.

- 3. <u>Severability</u>. The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable, and the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.
- 4. <u>**Conflict**</u>. All orders, resolutions, or Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent they conflict with this Ordinance.

5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
