

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-02

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 2012-06: An Ordinance Provided for the Appropriation of Funds for the Operation of the Village of Pecatonica in the County of Winnebago and State of Illinois for 2012 Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2012 and Ending April 30, 2013

WHEREAS, The Village of Pecatonica, adopted Ordinance Number 2012-06, Annual Appropriations Ordinance on June 19, 2012.

WHEREAS, Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 65, Section 5/8-2-7 and 9, allows the Village at any time after passage, by 2/3 vote of the Corporate Authorities, to make transfers within any department or other separate agency of the Municipal Government, of sums of money appropriated for one corporate object or purpose to another corporate object or purpose provided any transfer not be reduced below an amount sufficient to cover all obligations incurred or to be incurred against that appropriation; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to move monies at this time, and the corporate authorities desire to make the transfers within a department or other separate agency of the Village of sums of money appropriated for one corporate object or purpose to another corporate object or purpose,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Pecatonica, Illinois, that,

Section 1: Ordinance Number 2012-06, the Annual Appropriation Ordinance, is hereby amended as shown on attached EXHIBIT A. Additionally, the Board of Trustees approves the new appropriation amounts to be used as the budget amounts for each line item.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.
