

ORDINANCE 2014-29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ESTABLISHING THE SCHEDULE OF MEETINGS FOR THE VILLAGE BOARD FOR THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, ILLINOIS AND CREATING A COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

WHEREAS, The VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, Illinois (the **Village**) is a duly organized Illinois Municipal Corporation operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-1, et. seq.); and,

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to amend and establish a schedule of meetings for the Village Board and to amend Article One, Chapter Two, Section 2.A. of the Code of Ordinances of the Village; and

WHEREAS, The Village wishes to abolish some of its standing committees and create a Committee of the Whole to address committee matters;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PECATONICA, COUNTY OF WINNEBAGO, STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: Effective January 1, 2015, Article One, Chapter Two, Section 2. A. is amended as follows:

A.i. The Board of Trustees shall meet as a Committee of the Whole on the First Thursday of each month beginning at 6:00 P.M. provided that if such meeting date shall fall on a legal holiday the meeting shall be held at the same hour on the following day.

A.ii. The Regular meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held on the Third Tuesday of each month beginning at 6:00 P.M. provided that if such meeting date shall fall on a legal holiday the meeting shall be held at the same hour on the following day.

SECTION 2: The Public Works/Public Safety Committee and the Finance Committee are hereby abolished as standing committees and their duties and responsibilities will be undertaken by the Board of Trustees acting as a Committee of the Whole. The Economic Development Committee will remain as a separate Committee and continue to meet on the Second Monday of each month.

SECTION 3: The attached schedule of meetings (Exhibit A) is hereby adopted and The Village Clerk is directed to publish the same.

SECTION 4: This ordinance supersedes all prior ordinances or parts thereof adopted prior hereto which are in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions thereof.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
